


CZECH OPEN INSTITUTE

Administrative offices of the Czech Open Institute are located in the center of the Czech Republic – Brandýs nad Labem – Stará Boleslav. The education takes place in many different places of the Czechia, usually in tourist centers, that usually offer, beyond the main season, the best conditions for study – comfortable accommodation, quality food, undisturbed atmosphere for concentrated study. There are also good possibilities for rest – you can work out as well as have a beer with your friends in a typical Czech pub.



PROJECTS

OUR SERVICES

All foreigners are allowed to study at the state universities for free – after passing the entrance exams and study in Czech language.

Brandýs nad Labem – Stará Boleslav (15 thousand inhabitants) is one of the oldest towns of the Czech Republic. Already in 10th century it became a religious center, later it was favored by Austrian emperors from the Habsburg family. Its famous history is reminded by churches, Jewish cemetery, or the town gate. For potential students may be interesting, that there is a Pedagogical Faculty of the Charles University in the town. Those who prefer active relaxation will appreciate two large lakes, blacktop bike – roads in near forests, two football fields, athletic stadium, squash courts, bowling, billiards. In the evenings you may visit clubs, discos, restaurants, typical Czech pubs... The town is perfectly connected not only to Prague (the journey by scheduled buses to the nearest subway station takes about 15 minutes), but also to many other places of the country, even the most popular rest-place, Krkonoše.

Foreign students usually arrive to Prague – Ruzyně airport, or to any of Prague international bus or railway stations. There they are always awaited by our co-workers. Even if you get lost, there will be duties in our seat, that will help you. You can call it to the number you will get together with the description of the place and time of the appointment.
